Dear Families

Welcome back for term 2! I hope you enjoyed the glorious Autumn weather over the break. I travelled to the Sunshine Coast, Bowral and Sydney. One of my passions is musical theatre and I thoroughly enjoyed seeing "Charlie and the Chocolate Factory" in Sydney!

Cybersafety is of the utmost importance to us. In recent times there have been a couple of incidents that have prompted us to readjust our student **Code of Practice for ICT**. Please get in contact with your child's teacher if you have any concerns. We will be discussing this with all students in the coming days. The agreement wording is below and we will be asking students to sign after our discussing with them. Students will have signed agreements in previous years but we have made the language more relevant and current.

### Code of Practice for Students

When using ICT resources at Lyneham Primary School (including the internet, email, Digital Backpack, Google Apps for Education (G-Suite), Oliver Library, Seesaw, iPads, IWBs etc): I will use school devices only with the permission of a teacher. I will follow all instructions from teachers when using school devices. I will not let anyone else know my passwords. I know that I am responsible for anything that happens when my account is used. I know that the school and the Education Directorate receives information about anything that I send or receive. I will tell my teacher if

I think someone has gained access to my account. I will make sure any work that I wish to have published, any email I send, or any comments I post are polite and carefully written and presented. I will respect other students' work and ensure appropriate feedback about individual responses. I will not read other people's emails. I will not tell anyone my address or the address or telephone number of anyone else or send/post photographs of myself or others. I will use material from other websites only if I have permission to do so. If I use material in my work that I have found on the internet, I will say where it comes from.

**If I see or receive any information on the computer that makes me feel uncomfortable or is inappropriate I will tell a teacher straight away, or report it using the Cyber Safety Button on the Digital Backpack.**

**I will not damage or disable the electronic devices, software systems or computer networks of the school.**

**I will not send, create, show or search for things that might upset others.**

I have read and understand the Lyneham Primary School Acceptable Use of ICT Code of Practice for Students. I understand that disciplinary action may be taken if I do not follow this agreement, which may include loss of access to certain ICT functions or not being able to use ICT at all for a period of time.

### **Enrolment processes for all ACT government schools**

There is a streamlined process for enrolments for ALL government schools, from preschool to year 12. Enrolment forms are ALL to be completed online (if support/access is required, we can help). Applications for 2020 opened on Monday 29th April. Schools look at enrolment applications and accept enrolments based on criteria outlined in the Directorate policy taking into account the school's Enrolment Management Plan. A school's Enrolment Management Plan takes into account school capacity, context and enrolment trends. Our Priority Enrolment Area includes the suburbs of Lyneham, North Lyneham, Downer and O'Connor (north of Macarthur Avenue). Thus, I ask all current Lyneham families to help us with spreading the word to inform prospective families for 2020 of these processes and to contact the office should they require any clarification. Our existing preschool families at Downer Preschool and Lyneham Preschool **do not** have to re-enrol for Kindergarten at Lyneham Primary. A 2020 Kindergarten Information session is planned for Wednesday 22nd May. All year 6 families should be looking to their high schools for ongoing information for 2020.
